OLD BUSINESS:

2020 donations:

NEW BUSINESS:

Slow Spokes:

- Craig P was invited to the Slow Spokes meeting on Jan. 8. Since the group stopped the Peach of a Ride, they offered to donate equipment and other stuff to CRR for the BWR ride. This included SAG signs, water coolers, vests and more for events.
 - Craig suggested that CRR add a 12-mile family friendly route to BWR called Peach of a Route.
 - The route will be on Harsen's Island and Slow Spokes agreed to staff volunteers along the route.
 - The new route will have the same registration fee (includes ferry, lunch, etc).
 - Slow Spokes agreed to share their ride mailing list with CRR
 - Members thought this new route is a good idea. Heather pointed out that it's a great opportunity to target families with a shorter route (more marketing opportunities for BWR).
