These awards will necessitate that ride leaders turn in ride sign in sheets for every club ride and for total mileage awards the individuals must inform Ray Dominick of rides completed at the first monthly meeting after the ride. The total mileage awards will also consider miles ridden to and from ride. (by bike of course).
