THE CHALLENGE

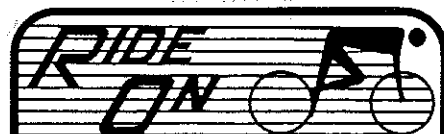

Tuesdays- Meet Ron Skiba at Pavlat's at 6:30 p.m. for a B pace, 25 mile ride to Metro Beach.

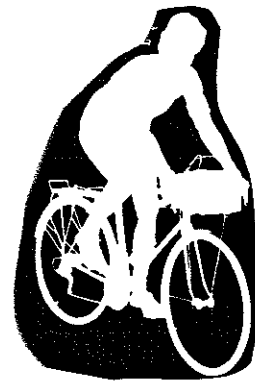
