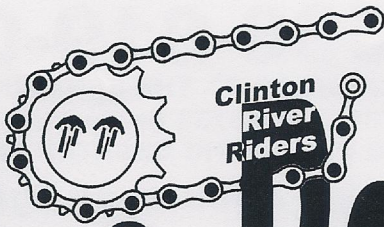

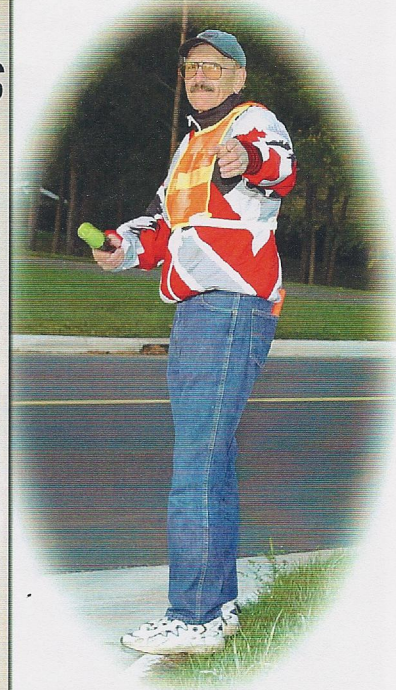

Once again, congratulations to all and I look forward to BWR 2003.

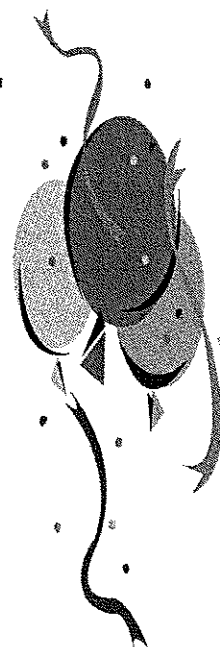
