WALLYBALL

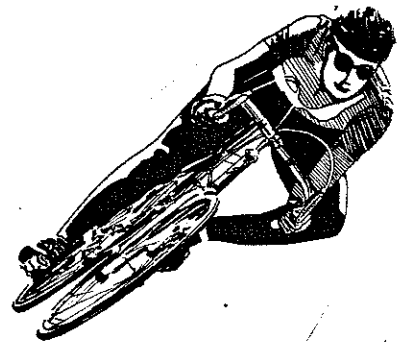
