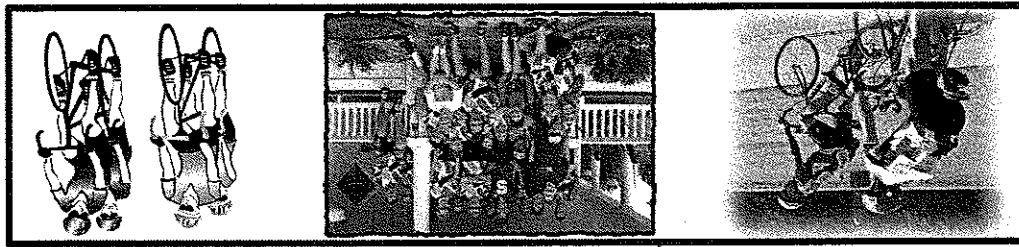
★ Bev Clark is running for LMB Region 2. Good Luck Bev!

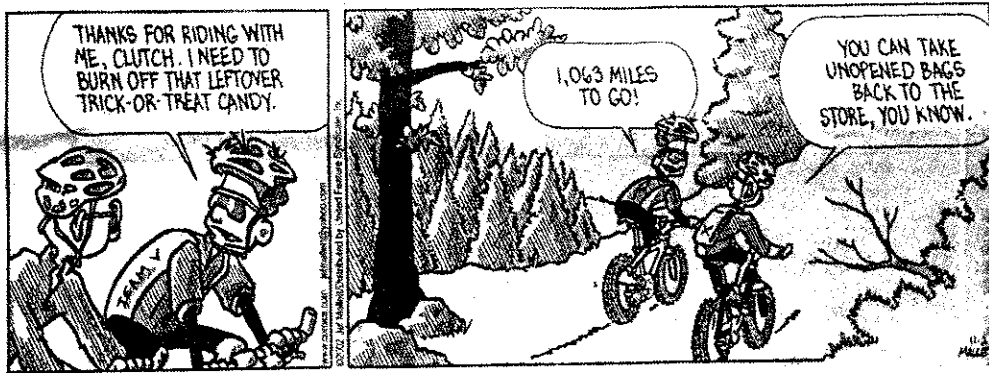
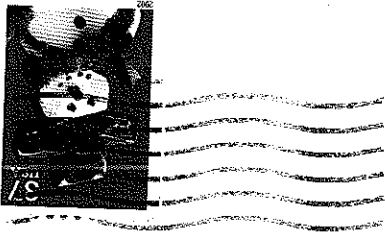
